How do I record Minutes?

READING RULES

1. Reading before the official beginning of the Read-a-thon DOES NOT count.
2. Reading before & after school DOES count.
3. Reading during class time DOES NOT count.
4. Reading assigned homework, including book report reading, DOES count.
5. Reading instead of doing your homework DOES NOT count.
6. Being read to by other people DOES count.
7. Reading aloud to the dog, cat or any other pet DOES count.
8. Reading aloud to other people DOES count. Reading to someone also doing the Read-a-Thon counts for both of you!!
